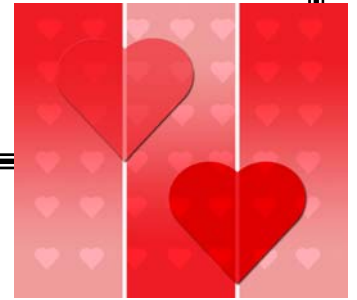

Bond Levy Vote

The April 8th ballot will include two questions for a \$20 million bond and 26-cent operating levy for voters in the NKC school district. This is the first time in seven years that the school board has asked for a tax increase.
