Field Trips

Lisa Sparks reports that busses for Field Trips were planned/budgeted as one Field Trip per teacher/per grade. In other words, each teacher could plan one regular Field Trip and the PTA would cover the transportation costs.

This is discussed to figure out where to pull PTA funds from to cover the 2nd and 3rd grade Wizard of Oz Field Trip to Staley High School.

Sandi Brown asks where PTA can pull funds from to cover the transportation costs.

Kathy D'Anza states that she can cover the cost of the Oz Field Trip. Kathy

also reports that she did not realize that the PTA budget was for one Field Trip per teacher/per grade.

Sandi Brown questions if this can be covered from Literature Festival funds since we has discussed doing something for the other grades (other than 4th and 5th). Question: Is there enough money remaining in the Literature Festival budget to cover this Field Trip? Without Courtney Wheeler available to ask – no one is sure.

Jill Hoover suggests that the costs and allotment of Field Trip funds should be reviewed at the next budget meeting.
