NKC School Board Presentation - Building a Better Future

Dr. Evans - Assistant Superintendant of Operations

- Presentation on Levy Transfer & Bond 2022 -
- Phase 2 of the 10-year facilities plan includes Nashua in Phase 2A this would be along with a
 Rising Hill addition & Crestview Elementary building. Nashua will have a new building built while
 the school learning continues in the current Nashua building. Plans for Nashua Elementary's new
 building to open Fall 2024
- Bonds are for building, Levies are for learning (Operational costs)
- A yes vote will not change the tax, simply move \$0.20 to the operational levy moving \$7M to provide for additional staff, ensuring health benefits, addressing the increased cost of operations. There will NOT be a tax increase, the taxes will remain the same.
- April 5th is the day to vote!
